




Chart I: Religious demography adopted from Data extracted from 2014 National Population and Housing Census

Non Believers Baseline Survey in Uganda





Prayer and Worship helps people to cope by denial, many religious Africans seem to be contented with the problems at hand and choose to ignore them as if they are not real, do not exist.




 Religion has helped in promoting bad leadership and dictatorship in Africa.






